What Does Choice90^{Rx} Mean to You?

Choice—You may have your prescriptions filled at a local retail pharmacy or through mail order. You decide what's best for you.

Convenience—If you take medication on an ongoing basis, you can obtain up to a 90-day supply from a neighborhood pharmacy for three (3) retail co-payments. You save time by filling prescriptions less often.

Timeliness & Peace of Mind—You can find a participating pharmacy close to home. You have peace of mind knowing that your prescription is being filled by the pharmacy of your choice.

Personal Interaction—Counseling from a pharmacist can help you understand the benefits and risks of your medications and other health issues.

Your pharmacist is available to answer questions every time you drop off and pick up your medications.

Web Services—Many participating pharmacies offer online ordering for prescription refills.

You can also request refill reminder emails or set up automatic refill shipments. Your pharmacist can talk to you about available services.

Safety & Privacy—The system maintains your prescription history to determine if there may be any interaction problems with

your drug therapy. All personal information remains completely confidential.

How it Works

When you need a prescription for medication taken on an ongoing basis, tell your doctor about Choice90^{Rx}!

1. For new prescription medication:

a. Ask your doctor for up to a 30-day supply of the medication on one prescription. This ensures the dosage and therapy is appropriate for your treatment.

b. Also, ask for another prescription to allow a refill for up to a 90-day supply of the same medication to continue the therapy.

For refills:

Ask your doctor to specify up to a 90-day supply of medication on the prescription.

- 2. Take the prescriptions to a participating Choice90^{Rx} pharmacy and present your identification card.
- 3. Your pharmacist will process the prescription and request the appropriate co-payment amount.
